



Spring 2017 Semester - At A Glance Changes. v2

Sandy Creek Transit Center is now open. The following routes now access Sandy Creek Transit Center:

- **Sandy Creek Metro (Replaces Mason to Metro) - Bay A**
- **Gunston Go-Bus (George & Mason) - Bay B**
- **SciTech Campus - Bay D**
- **Burke Centre VRE Express - Bay E**

Overall, we have done our best not to change arrival and departure times on almost every route. Check shuttle.gmu.edu to view, download or print schedules or go to the ride systems app.

The **West Campus Shuttle** is now the only route that circles the university. We did this to improve reliability and reduce delays, especially on the Metro and SciTech routes.

Most of the service that was **temporarily re-routed** to Presidents Park is back up to Sandy Creek Transit Center. Only the West Campus Shuttle now stops at Presidents Park.

The **Sandy Creek Metro** route (*Formerly Metro to Mason*) has been streamlined to assist in on-time performance. This route now starts at Sandy Creek Transit Center, then proceeds to Masonvale & Staffordshire Ln., Rappahannock River Ln. (Shelter #1). This route will drop off at Finley Lot on the return trip as well as other stops on campus. Please visit shuttle.gmu.edu for more information.

Global Center Metro (*Formerly Metro Express*) now starts at Mason's Global Center, then continues to the RAC, then on to Rappahannock River Ln. (Shelter #1) on its way to Vienna Metro. This route drops off passengers coming from Vienna Metro at the Finley Lot stop once it enters the campus, then proceeds to the routes other drop-off points. Again, please check our new schedules online.

The **SciTech Campus** route starts at Sandy Creek Transit Center and then stops at Masonvale & Staffordshire Ln., Finley Lot stop and the RAC. Note: Upon arriving back to the Fairfax Campus, this route will drop-off passengers along Rappahannock River Ln. as well as other stops on campus.

We added two additional trips on the **Gunston Go-Bus - George route** in the afternoon to help ease over-crowding.

New stops at Target and along Zion Dr. (one near Roberts Rd.) on the **Burke Centre VRE Express** route will increase access to these important areas. Note: These stops occur only on the return trip from VRE. See the new route map on the Burke Centre VRE schedule for more details.

We have created more traditional timetables or schedules. They now include route maps and additional information about each route. Visit shuttle.gmu.edu or pick up a hard copy at Sandy Creek Transit Center, the JC and/or most of the information desks across campus.
